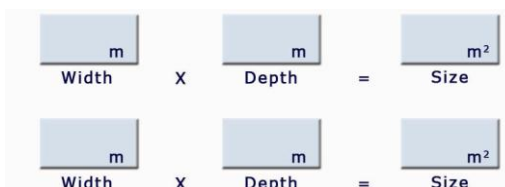

Registration

A stand is ordered by using the present registration form. The closing date for registrations for EnergyTech 2011 is August 30th 2011. The contract between the exhibitor and the event organizers shall come into existence upon receipt of confirmation of the admission notice or of the invoice by the exhibitor.

Admission, Exhibits

The event organizers decide about admitting exhibitors exercising due discretion. They are entitled to reject applications for admission having due regard for the spatial capacities they have made available for the event as well as the purpose and structure of the event to be determined by them.

The exhibitor undertakes to provide the event organizers with sufficient information about his company and the subjects and products to be exhibited by him together with his registration. Admission to participate shall be based on said information. If the exhibitor intends to exhibit several subjects and products on his stand, he must state the percentage share of the individual subjects and products. Only such subjects and products as have been registered and admitted may be exhibited. If the intended or actual presentation at the event does not comply with the particulars given beforehand, the event organizers shall be entitled to exclude the exhibitor from participating in the fair immediately. In that event, the event organizers reserve the right to claim a contract penalty in the amount of 100% of the booked stand space and to exclude the exhibitor from taking part in future events.

Upon request, the exhibitor shall be notified in advance of the costs of the utility systems provided upon application by the exhibitor and of other ancillary services (gas, water, electricity, sanitary and telecommunications connections etc.), which will be supplied and invoiced via Quantum Business Group Ltd. To all costs invoiced the additional Israeli VAT must be applied by law. Applications for such connections can only be considered if they are received by Quantum Business Group Ltd. no later than four weeks prior to the start of the event. For electricity and water installations, ceiling suspensions, security service, cleaning personnel, and when equipment is used (cranes, fork-lift trucks, scaffolding) only the service partners designated by Quantum Business Group Ltd. may be commissioned. Technical services rendered by Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be invoiced to the exhibitor by Quantum Business Group Ltd. directly.

Stand Allocation and Design

Stands will be allocated by Quantum Business Group Ltd. Stands will be allocated according to the event organizer's requirements and possibilities, and in accordance with the sector classification system for the trade fair as applied by them at their own discretion, and not according to the order in which registrations are received. The exhibitor is not entitled to sub-let or otherwise surrender the stand allocated to him to third parties, or to exchange it, either in whole or in part. Co / Sub-exhibitors must be applied with the corresponding form on www.energytech.co.il. If the event organizers allow co / sub-letting to a co / sub-exhibitor, co / sub-exhibitor a fee of € 350 shall be payable. Additional services for co / sub-exhibitors can only be booked by the main exhibitor and will be invoiced to the main exhibitor.

The main exhibitor is responsible for informing his co / sub-exhibitors about +any booking possibilities.

Joint Stands

If several exhibitors rent a stand jointly, each of them shall be jointly and severally liable. In the registration form they must name a joint representative who is authorized to give and receive declarations in the name of the participating exhibitors. Additional services for participants of the joint stand can only be booked by the joint representative. The joint representative is responsible for informing all participants about any booking possibilities.

Stand Design

The name and address of the stand holder must be affixed to every stand in a manner that is discernible to everyone for the entire duration of the exhibition. The stand fittings are a matter for the exhibitor. When designing exhibition stands, stand partition walls to neighboring stands and carpet flooring are compulsory. Stand constructions over and above 3 m high require special permission by Quantum Business Group Ltd. At the boundary towards stand neighbors, a structural height of 4.00 m (upper edge) may not be exceeded. All back walls facing neighbor stands must be clean and neutral. Structural elements and fittings and equipment must be arranged within the limits of the stand in such a manner that neighboring exhibitors are not thereby impaired. All materials used must be flame resistant. The right to impose further restrictions on the stand design is reserved. Any special structures must be submitted to the trade fair management at least 3 months before the start of the trade fair.

Two-Storey Stands

Two-storey exhibition stands require the prior consent of Quantum Business Group Ltd. and, if necessary, a permit from the competent authorities. A premium of 50% of the stand area built-over is charged in the case of a two-storey stand construction.

Use of Stand

Opening Times

The opening times of EnergyTech 2011 are as follows:

21st September 2011 10:00 – 18:00

22nd September 2011 10:00 – 18:00

The exhibitor is obliged to keep the exhibition stand adequately staffed with personnel throughout the entire opening times of the event.

In the case of non-compliance the event organizers shall impose a contract penalty in the amount of 25% of the booked stand space, minimum 500 €, and reserve the right to exclude the exhibitor from taking part in future events.

Using the Stand outside the Opening Times

Quantum Business Group Ltd. must be given written notice of any use of the exhibition stand outside the trade fair opening hours (meetings, stand parties) at least eight weeks before the event. Such use requires the express written consent of Quantum Business Group Ltd. The cost of any additional hall security required for this depends on the size of the stand and number of persons present and shall be paid in full by the exhibitor. It is possible to use stands up to a maximum of 10.00 pm.

Exhibitor's Promotional Activities and Events

Promotional activities are limited to the exhibitor's own exhibition stand. Gambling, raffles, lotteries and competitions that are dependent on entrance tickets are basically prohibited. Promotions in the aisles and on common spaces are prohibited. Events outside the trade fair site are prohibited during the trade fair's opening hours if said events mean that participants in said events are kept from visiting EnergyTech 2011. This also applies to receptions, invitations, works tours and other tours. In case of doubt, the exhibitor must consult Quantum Business Group Ltd. in advance. If Quantum Business Group Ltd. comes to the conclusion that there is an event in the above-mentioned sense, the exhibitor shall refrain from proceeding with the event. If the exhibitor breaches the above obligations, Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall, at its option, have the following rights: Immediate closure of the stand and/or a prohibition from entering the premises and/or exclusion of the exhibitor from the next EnergyTech. Any assertion of said rights does not release the exhibitor from the payment obligations arising out of the stand rental agreement.

Serving Food or Beverages

The serving of light refreshments or beverages (including samples) of any kind against payment requires a special permit from Quantum Business Group Ltd. as well as a license under restaurant and catering law. The exhibitor is himself responsible for this. Serving of food or beverages (including samples) - even free of charge - if the exhibitor is supplied with said food or beverages by a professional caterer other than the official supplier of the Trade Fairs & Convention Center, Tel Aviv; is prohibited. The serving of alcoholic drinks requires an additional permit under Israeli law, even if served free of charge. The exhibitor is himself responsible for this too. The said permit can be obtained via the services of the official caterer of Trade Fairs & Convention

Dates for Set-up and Dismantling Set-Up

Start of set-up: Monday September 19th 2011, 12:00 (am)

End of set-up: Tuesday, September 20th 2011, 22:00.

Except on the last set-up day, the exhibition halls are open during the set-up period from 10:00 until 20.00.

Stands, which have not started to be set-up by 14.00 am on September 19th 2011 shall be set up and decorated at the exhibitor's cost unless they are otherwise disposed of or have obtained special permit to do so up to 24 hour prior to the said date. The tenant cannot assert any claim for damages; all of the payment obligations arising out of the stand rental agreement shall continue to exist.

Dismantling

Start of dismantling: Thursday, September 22nd 2011, 18:00.

End of dismantling: Thursday, September 22nd 2011, 24:00.

Dismantling shall be possible throughout this period. The stands and areas must be returned in an orderly condition. The exhibitor shall be liable for any damage to the stand equipment, the walls, the floor and the premises. Material set up outdoors must be removed in its entirety and the original condition of the premises must be restored.

Additional Set-Up Days

Additional Set-up days are not possible

Official onsite-handling agent

Kindly note that in all cases "Hermes Exhibitions & Projects" is the exclusive onsite-handling agents for EnergyTech 2011.

Liability, Insurance

The exhibition management recommends that exhibition insurance - which can include the delivery and removal of the exhibits - and a third-party liability insurance for personal injury and damage to property be taken out. All goods must be fully insured with all risk coverage. Insurance can be provided upon request. We regret that we can take no responsibility for goods after delivery to the exhibitors stand regardless if the exhibitor is present or not. Failure to comply with the said above relieves Quantum Business Group Ltd. from any possible liability and the exhibitor waives the right for any future claim or proceedings against Quantum Business Group Ltd.

Rescission / Cancellation of the Agreement

If, following a binding registration or completed contract conclusion, the event organizers allow an exhibitor, by way of exception, to withdraw the registration or to cancel the contract, the exhibitor must pay Quantum Business Group Ltd. a lump sum as compensation (lump-sum damages). The amount of the lump-sum damages depends on when Quantum Business Group Ltd. receives the notice from the exhibitor that he wishes to withdraw his binding registration or from the completed contract conclusion:

Time when the exhibitor's notice is received by Quantum Business Group Ltd.	Amount of lump-sum damages as a percentage of the fee and the payments, to which Quantum Business Group Ltd. would be entitled if the contract were implemented
Less than 5 months before the first day of the exhibition	100%
Less than seven, but five months or more, before the first day of the exhibition	75%
Seven months or more before the first day of the exhibition	50%

In addition to the flat-rate damages the exhibitor must reimburse any costs incurred at his instigation arising out of orders already placed.

Any request for rescission or request to cancel the contract can only be made in writing. The rescission or the cancellation of the contract is only agreed with legal effect if Quantum Business Group Ltd. has consented thereto in writing. Quantum Business Group Ltd. can make its consent dependent on whether the rented stand can be rented out to anyone else. If the stand cannot be rented out to anyone else, Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be entitled to move another exhibitor to the unoccupied stand or to otherwise fill the stand in the interests of the overall appearance. Any costs incurred for decoration or for filling the unoccupied stand shall be borne by the exhibitor.

Promotional Activities of the Event Organizer

Quantum Business Group Ltd. are entitled to use the name and the company logo of the exhibitor in connection with advertising for the purposes of attracting exhibitors and visitors for EnergyTech 2011 in whatever form (brochures, the trade fair catalogue, advertisements, posters, internet etc.). For this purpose, the exhibitor shall provide a file in electronic form with the company lettering and logo.

House Rules

The house rules and the regulations governing use of Trade Fairs & Convention Center, Tel Aviv shall apply to the exhibition site, which rules and regulations shall be sent to the exhibitor together with the technical documentation.

This Agreement shall be governed by Israeli law. The place of jurisdiction for all legal disputes in connection with this Agreement shall be Beer Sheva, Israel. In addition, the exhibitor can - at Quantum Business Group Ltd.'s option - be sued at the place where he has his registered office (seat).

General Terms and Conditions of Participation in EnergyTech 2011 in Tel Aviv

1. Registration

All potential exhibitors wishing to take part in the event must express their wish to do so by fully completing and signing the "Registration" form and submitting it to Quantum Business Group Ltd. by the registration deadline. All exhibits must be precisely described in the registration form. Co-exhibitors and additionally represented companies must be applied with the corresponding form on www.energytech.co.il. The same particulars must be specified as for the exhibitor.

2. Admission

These Terms and Conditions of Participation and the valid Technical Guidelines, available on www.energytech.co.il, are acknowledged as legally binding upon submission of the registration.

The contract for the rental of the stand space and the exhibitor's participation at the trade fair or exhibition shall not take effect until the exhibitor has been admitted by Quantum Business Group Ltd. There is no legal right to admission, unless any such right is derived from statute. Companies, who have not fulfilled their financial obligations to Quantum Business Group Ltd., e.g. arising out of previous events, or who at previous events have infringed the regulations governing the use of the Trade Fairs & Convention Center, Tel Aviv, or the Terms and Conditions of Participation, may be excluded from admission. Quantum Business Group Ltd. is entitled to withdraw from the contract or to terminate the contractual relationship without notice if admission was granted on the basis of incorrect or incomplete statements by the exhibitor, or if, at a later date, the exhibitor no longer fulfils the conditions for admission. Only such items as have been registered and admitted may be exhibited.

Quantum Business Group Ltd. has the right to remove any other exhibits at the exhibitor's risk and expense. Hired or leased items may not be exhibited; Quantum Business Group Ltd. is entitled to remove any such objects at the exhibitor's risk and expense. An exception is made in the case of objects which are not part of the exhibitor's range of goods, but which are required for their display (e.g. for demonstration purposes). Co-exhibitors may only be admitted, and additional organizations may only be represented, if this has been expressly stipulated in the notice of admission. Quantum Business Group Ltd. reserves the right to deviate from the type, size, and location of the exhibition area desired by the exhibitor, to exclude certain exhibits from admission, and to impose conditions on admission. The exhibitor's reservations, conditions, and particular wishes (e.g. regarding location, exclusion of competitors, stand construction or design) will be taken into account only if expressly confirmed in the notice of admission.

Space will be allocated according to Quantum Business Group Ltd's requirements and possibilities, and in accordance with the sector classification system for the trade fair as applied by Quantum Business Group Ltd. at its own discretion, and not according to the order in which registrations are received.

3. Rental Contract

The rental contract comes into force when Quantum Business Group Ltd. has notified the exhibitor in writing that he has been admitted; this generally occurs with confirmation of the order and has no connection with placement. The allocation of the other stands, in particular also of neighboring stands, can change up until the time the trade fair opens; Quantum Business Group Ltd. is also entitled to relocate or close entrances to and exits from the trade fair site and halls, and to make other reasonable alterations. No claims against Quantum Business Group Ltd. can be derived there from.

Quantum Business Group Ltd. may also subsequently make changes to the space allocation, in particular it may change the location, type, dimensions and size as a whole of the exhibitor's exhibition area, insofar as this is necessary for reasons of safety or public order, or because the trade fair is oversubscribed and further exhibitors must be admitted or because changes in the allocation of space are necessary in order to ensure that the premises and space required for the trade fair are used more efficiently. However, any such subsequent changes may not exceed the scope which the exhibitor can reasonably be expected to accept. Should such subsequent changes result in a lower participation fee, the difference in amount shall be refunded to the exhibitor. Any further claims against Quantum Business Group Ltd. are excluded. If the exhibitor cannot use its stand space or is impaired in its use of its stands because it has infringed legal or official regulations or provisions of the Terms and Conditions of Participation or the Technical Guidelines, said exhibitor shall nevertheless be obliged to pay the participation fee in full and to pay Quantum Business Group Ltd. compensation for all damage caused by the conduct of the exhibitor, its statutory representatives or vicarious agents; the exhibitor shall have no right to cancel or terminate the contract unless such a right derives mandatorily from the law.

4. Co-Exhibitors and Additionally Represented Companies

A co-exhibitor is someone who presents his own goods or services, using his own staff on the stand of another exhibitor (the main tenant). This also includes group companies and subsidiaries. Agents and representatives are not admitted as co-exhibitors. In the case of an exhibitor, who is himself a manufacturer, any and each further company, whose goods or services are offered by the exhibitor, shall be deemed to be an additionally represented company. If an exhibitor, who is a distribution company, displays not only the products of one manufacturer but also the goods and services of other companies, then the latter shall be deemed to be additionally represented companies. Admission of the exhibitor does not bring about a contract between the co-exhibitors or additionally represented companies and Quantum Business Group Ltd. The inclusion of co-exhibitors is subject to a charge; a fee is incurred for additionally represented companies. The fee is payable by the exhibitor; it can also still be invoiced subsequently by Quantum Business Group Ltd. The exhibitor is responsible for ensuring that his co-exhibitors and the other companies he additionally represents comply with the Exhibition Terms and Conditions, the Terms and Conditions of Participation, the Technical Guidelines as well as any orders given by the trade fair management. The exhibitor is liable for any intent or negligence on the part of his co-exhibitors or additionally represented companies as if said intent or negligence were his own. If the co-exhibitors make direct use of Quantum Business Group Ltd.'s services, Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be entitled to invoice the exhibitor for said services; the exhibitor shall be jointly and severally liable for this. The exhibitor may not move, exchange or share his stand, nor may he surrender it either in whole or in part to third parties, without the prior written consent of Quantum Business Group Ltd.

5. Cancellation of Contract

If the location, type, dimensions or size of the exhibition area rented by the exhibitor are subsequently changed to an extent which the exhibitor can no longer be reasonably expected to accept, the exhibitor shall be entitled to rescind the rental contract within a deadline of one week following receipt of Quantum Business Group Ltd.'s written notice. Otherwise, apart from his statutory rights of rescission, the exhibitor shall have no right to rescind this contract. If the exhibitor declares his rescission of the contract – regardless of whether he has a right of rescission or not – this shall mean that the exhibitor has thereby declared his final and absolute relinquishment of the right to participate in the trade fair. If the exhibitor declares his rescission and thereby his final and absolute relinquishment of the right to participate in the trade fair,

Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall then be entitled to re-let the stand space or to use it itself, without being so obliged, even if the exhibitor has no right of rescission.

If the exhibitor has declared his rescission without having a right of rescission, the exhibitor shall be obliged to pay the participation fee, whereby however Quantum Business Group Ltd. must accept deduction of the expenses saved and of the benefits it has derived by re-letting or by otherwise using the exhibition area. For expenses incurred by Quantum Business Group Ltd. due to the exhibitor rescinding the contract for any reason and thereby cancelling his participation in the trade fair contrary to his duty, the exhibitor must additionally pay Quantum Business Group Ltd. flat-rate compensation in the amount of 125% of the agreed participation fee. Quantum Business Group Ltd's right to demand further damages shall remain unaffected. The exhibitor can demand that the flat-rate compensation be reduced if the exhibitor proves that Quantum Business Group Ltd. incurred less damage. Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be entitled to rescind the contract if the exhibitor is late with its payment obligations owed towards Quantum Business Group Ltd., Quantum Business Group Ltd. has extended the exhibitor's deadline by 5 days and said deadline has expired to no avail. Quantum Business Group Ltd. is also entitled to rescind the contract if the exhibitor breaches a duty arising out of this contract to respect Quantum Business Group Ltd's rights, legally protected rights and interests and Quantum Business Group Ltd. can no longer reasonably be expected to adhere to the contract. In the aforementioned cases, Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be entitled not only to rescind the contract but also to demand the agreed participation fee from the exhibitor as flat-rate compensation. Quantum Business Group Ltd's right to demand further damages shall remain unaffected.

6. Force Majeure, Cancellation of the Event

If Quantum Business Group Ltd. is compelled, as a result of force majeure or other circumstances for which it is not answerable (e.g. failure of the power supply), to vacate one or more exhibition areas temporarily or for longer periods, or to postpone or curtail the trade fair, the exhibitor shall not thereby acquire any rights of rescission or termination, nor any other claims, in particular claims for damages against Quantum Business Group Ltd.. If Quantum Business Group Ltd. cancels the event because it cannot hold the event as a result of force majeure or any other circumstances, or because it has become unreasonable for Quantum Business Group Ltd. to hold the event, Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall not be liable for damages and disadvantages to exhibitors arising from the cancellation of the event.

8. Warranty

Complaints about any defects in the stand or exhibition area are to be made in writing to Quantum Business Group Ltd. immediately upon occupying the exhibition area, but at the latest on the last day of the stand set-up period, so that Quantum Business Group Ltd. can remedy such defects. Later complaints cannot be considered and shall not give rise to any claims against Quantum Business Group Ltd.

9. Liability and Insurance

Quantum Business Group Ltd. is not liable for personal injury (damage arising from injury to life, body or health). Quantum Business Group Ltd. is not liable due to a breach of duty for which Quantum Business Group Ltd., its statutory representatives or vicarious agents are answerable, as well as for other damage due to an intentional or grossly negligent breach of duty by Quantum Business Group Ltd., its statutory representatives or vicarious agents. Quantum Business Group Ltd. is also liable for any damage due to a negligent breach of cardinal duties by Quantum Business Group Ltd., its statutory representatives or its vicarious agents.

If the exhibitors are entrepreneurs, legal entities under public law or special bodies or funds under public law, Quantum Business Group Ltd. is under no circumstances liable for damage to or loss of goods brought to the trade fair by the exhibitor or the stand fittings or furnishings. In this case, it is immaterial whether such damage or loss occurs before, during or after the trade fair. The same applies to vehicles left on the trade fair site by exhibitors, their employees or agents. For his part, the exhibitor is liable for any damage to persons or property caused intentionally or negligently to himself, his employees, his agents, his exhibition property and exhibition facilities and equipment. Each exhibitor is obliged to take out such insurance with sufficient insurance cover with an insurance company licensed to operate in the State of Israel and to pay the premiums incurred (including insurance tax) in good time. Corresponding insurance can be applied for by using the pre-printed forms in the Exhibitor Service Package.

10. Photography, Filming, Video Recording, and Sketching

Only persons authorized by Quantum Business Group Ltd. and in possession of a valid Quantum Business Group Ltd. pass may film, photograph, or make sketches or video recordings in the exhibition halls. Under no circumstances may photographic or other recordings be made of other exhibitors' stands. In the event of any failure to comply with this, Quantum Business Group Ltd. can demand that the recorded material be surrendered and can take legal steps to achieve this end. Photographs of stands which are to be taken outside normal opening hours and need special lighting require Quantum Business Group Ltd's consent. Such photographs require the main ring circuit to be switched on and therefore the presence of the hall electrician. The exhibitor shall bear the costs thereby incurred, insofar as they are not borne by the photographer. Quantum Business Group Ltd. is entitled to have photographs, drawings, films and video recordings made of events at the trade fair, of stands and exhibits, and to use them for advertising or general press publications.

11. Catering, Deliveries to Stands

The catering within the trade fair site shall be incumbent upon solely the caterers appointed by Quantum Business Group Ltd. Deliveries of beer or other beverages may be made only by companies tied to Quantum Business Group Ltd. by contract. The exhibitor must apply to the city authorities and Israeli law, Only limited deliveries to the exhibition stands are possible. Quantum Business Group Ltd. is entitled to permit deliveries to stands only at certain times.

12. Third party Rights

12.1 Publications by an exhibitor on "Energytech.co.il"

Quantum Business Group is able to allow exhibitors to provide information on the internet site "Energytech.co.il" for visitors, in particular in relation to exhibitor profiles, product information and job vacancies (overall "Exhibitor Information"). Pursuant to applicable laws, the exhibitor himself is responsible for this information. The exhibitor shall ensure before publication that he is legally entitled to publish the information (possesses the rights to distribute and to make available to the public) and that the published information complies with applicable competition laws and does not infringe any third party rights. The access authorization (user id and password) granted by Quantum Business Group Ltd. is not transferable and must be protected according to the current state of technology against loss or theft, unauthorized access or unauthorized transfer. The exhibitor shall inform the Quantum Business Group Ltd. immediately after discovering loss or theft, possible unauthorized access or transfer.

As a principle, the Quantum Business Group Ltd. is not obliged to review and control the Exhibitor Information before it is made available for access on the Web. If the rights of a third party are infringed due to or in connection with the Exhibitor Information and if (a) the Quantum Business Group Ltd. is informed of the infringement by the third party or (b) a third party lodge the appropriate claim against the Quantum Business Group Ltd., the Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall inform the exhibitor immediately after receiving the notice or notification of the claim by the third party. The exhibitor shall revise the Exhibitor Information without delay so that it no longer infringes the rights of a third party or by other means make the Exhibitor Information compliant with applicable laws. In the interim, the Quantum Business Group Ltd. is entitled to temporarily withdraw from publication the Exhibitor Information in question.

12.2 Exhibitor Code of Conduct

Quantum Business Group Ltd. expects that the exhibitors respect the industrial property rights of other exhibitors. If the Quantum Business Group Ltd. receives evidence by a legal decision that an exhibitor is infringing the industrial property rights of another exhibitor by way of the published Exhibitor Information (figure 12.1), the articles displayed, brochures, leaflets or by other means, the Quantum Business Group Ltd. is entitled but not obliged to temporarily or permanently remove the exhibited articles, Exhibitor Information, brochures and advertising material and if necessary to take these into safekeeping until the end of the exhibition. The Quantum Business Group Ltd. is also entitled but not obliged to close the exhibitor's stand and/or ask the exhibitor and his staff to leave the exhibition. In addition to this, the Quantum Business Group Ltd. can exclude the infringing exhibitor from future exhibitions. Should such measures prove unwarranted, any and all claims for damages and compensation against the Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be excluded unless there is evidence of gross negligence or intention.

12.3 Exemption, Claims for damages

In cases in line with figures 12.1 and 12.2, the exhibitor shall, upon first demand, defend, compensate, reimburse or indemnify the Quantum Business Group Ltd. for and against any damage occurring from the infringement of third party rights and which is asserted against the Quantum Business Group Ltd. Liability for damages is excluded if the exhibitor proves that he is not responsible for the infringement of the rights of the third party.

13. Exhibitor Passes

The exhibitors shall receive a reasonable number of exhibitor passes free of charge for the period of the trade fair. Exhibitor passes are non-transferable. Exhibitor passes may not be passed on to unauthorized third parties, e.g. to persons or companies who wish to offer goods for sale or render services on the trade fair site without corresponding authorization from Quantum Business Group Ltd. Exhibitor passes shall be issued only once the participation fee, the advance payment for services and the fee for admitting any co-exhibitors have been paid.

14. Setting Up and Dismantling Stands, Maintaining Stands

The dates fixed for setting up and dismantling must be strictly observed. Stands that are not occupied by the last day of the set-up period may be used by Quantum Business Group Ltd. in some other way. An exhibitor, who has been admitted to the fair, is obliged to participate in the event. All stands must be properly equipped and staffed by qualified personnel during the entire duration of the trade fair and the prescribed opening hours. Particular attention should be paid to ensuring that the stand is already fully staffed when the trade fair opens.

Exhibitors are not permitted to remove trade fair goods or dismantle their stands before the trade fair closes; in the event of any breach of this rule, Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be entitled to demand a contract penalty in the amount of 25% of the booked stand space, minimum 500 €. Notwithstanding its extraordinary right of termination pursuant to 5. Cancellation of Contract and the claiming of all costs thereby incurred by Quantum Business Group Ltd., Quantum Business Group Ltd. shall be entitled to exclude from future trade fairs exhibitors, who do not keep their stands staffed by appropriately qualified personnel during the trade fair's daily opening hours, who exhibit an incomplete range of goods or goods not admitted to the trade fair, who vacate or clear their stands before the end of the trade fair, or who otherwise infringe the Terms and Conditions of Participation.

15. Verbal Agreements

All verbal agreements, individual authorizations and special arrangements are valid only following written confirmation by Quantum Business Group Ltd.

16. Regulations on Use

The exhibitor must strictly observe the house rules and the regulations governing the use of the trade fair centre and its site (Trade Fairs & Convention Center, Tel Aviv.). It is not permitted to spend the night in the halls or on the grounds outside. The exhibitor must treat the other participants at the event with respect, may not act contrary to public moral policy and may not misuse its participation at the event for ideological, political or other such purposes as have nothing to do with the event.

17. Limitation of Actions, Preclusion Period

All the exhibitor's claims against FWTM arising out of the stand rental and any and all legal relations in connection therewith shall be time barred after a period of six months. The period of limitation starts at the end of the month in which the closing date of the trade fair falls. Notwithstanding the provisions agreed in Clause 8, any complaints about invoices must be made in writing within a preclusion period of 14 days following receipt thereof.

18. Data Protection

The exhibitor's personal data shall be processed and used for performing the business purposes of Quantum Business Group Ltd. having due regard for the statutory data protection provisions, and shall in particular be passed on to third parties as part of performing the purpose of the contract.

19. Savings Clause

In the case that the provisions of the Terms and Conditions of Participation or the Technical Guidelines are in part void or contain lacunae, the validity of the remaining provisions or of the contract shall not be affected thereby. In that case, the parties undertake to replace the void provision and/or to fill the lacuna with a provision with which the economic purpose being pursued by the parties can most likely be achieved.
